## **New eligibility**

• Hoosiers age 45+ • Pregnant individuals

**REMINDER:** Teachers and staff in pre-K through high school can now register at any vaccination site. This includes childcare centers; Head Start and Early Start programs; licensed childcare providers, including center-based and family care providers; classroom aides, bus drivers, janitors, counselors; administration staff, cafeteria workers and substitute teachers. **Proof of eligible employment is required.** (See eligibility list **HERE.**)






**Total Individuals Who Have Received a First Dose:**

#### **Total first doses**




### **Total individuals Fully Vaccinated**

### **Total Fully Vaccinated**



Here are the latest percentages of people who have scheduled or received a vaccine by age group. These percentages include nearly **145,000** first and second doses administered to residents and staff in long-term care facilities.

- 72% of Hoosiers 80+
- 63% of Hoosiers 60-69
- 75% of Hoosiers 70-79
- 43% of Hoosiers 50-59
- 23% of Hoosiers 45-49 (first two

days of eligibility)

### Who's eligible next

Waitlists should only re lect who's next in our <u>eligibility</u> <u>guidelines</u>. <u>Indiana's upcoming eligibility group</u>:

• Age 40 - 44

### **Homebound Hoosiers:**

About 2,500 fellow Hoosiers are represented in this system to reach out to individuals in their homes. So far, 300 residents have received vaccines and 145 are scheduled thanks to help from local EMS partners. Contact your local health department or **Area Agency on Aging** if you are eligible for vaccination and homebound.
